

- 5 schools in the outlying communities; Bogue Chitto (PreK-8); Tucker (PreK-8); Conehatta (PreK-8); Red Water (PreK-8); and Standing Pine (PreK-6)
- 3 schools in Choctaw; Pearl River Elementary (PreK-6); Choctaw Central Middle (7-8); and Choctaw Central High (9-12)
- 2173 Students
- Choctaw Technical Education Center
- Choctaw Virtual Learning Center
- Accredited by the Mississippi Department of Education through AdvancedEd
- Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians operates the largest unified Reservation school system in the United States
