Tribal IV-E Plans

- 574 recognized tribes in the US
- Only 11 have achieved IV-E program approval
- No tribes have approved IV-E plans in Region 2
- Tribes lose opportunities due to lack of technical expertise and personnel, which becomes a spiral of lost opportunities
- WE MUST PROVIDE TRUE OPPORTUNITIES
 TO TRIBES TO CLAIM FUNDING BY OFFERING
 TA AND SIMPLIFYING APPLICATION

Gaps in Culturally Relevant Family First Services

- Short list of approved programs
- Need for culturally relevant programs
- Approximately 30% of enrolled Native people live on reservations
- Urban Indians and those off-reservation deserve culturally relevant services

Data Gaps and ICWA Implementation Challenges

- States lack informative data about Native American children in their regions
- ICWA-responsive services not institutionalized
- Promising practices often rely on committed individuals

 WE MUST INSTITUTIONALIZE COURT AND CHILD WELFARE ICW ROLES AND SUPPORT STATE DATA COLLECTION RELATED TO NATIVE CHILDREN

Strengthening the Court Improvement Program

- Court Improvement Program has supported ICWA
- Tribal Court Improvement Programs allow for innovative culturally-specific programming in family tribal courts

 AN INVESTMENT IN ADDITIONAL ICWA-SPECIFIC CIP FUNDING COULD SUPPORT NATIONAL COURT IMPROVEMENTS FOR ICW
